Scope of Application

Ionda GmbH is the organiser of the European Creators' Lab, which will take place in May/June 2023. These "General Terms and Conditions" apply to the application procedure and the contractual relationship between the participant and the organiser of the Development Lab as part of the European Creators' Lab.

Target Group

The Development Lab is primarily for XR producers and creatives, creative technologists, filmmakers, screenwriters, performing artists, visual artists, game developers, journalists, communication professionals from marketing and advertising, museum and art curators, lecturers, storytellers, film or theatre directors. Participation is without own project.

Component and Coverage of the Development Lab

The Development Lab covers 3 online (live) masterclasses, 5 days workshop in Villeurbanne (Lyon) with international mentors and experts, 6 nights accommodation with breakfast in hotel, lunch catering, snacks and soft drinks, ticket for public transport between Villeurbanne and Lyon.

In addition, the organiser arranges networking activities and publishes the digital annual Booklet, which lists all participants and mentors and is intended for promotional purposes.

We will use the webinar tool Zoom for livestreaming the online masterclasses, and Miro for collaboration. You will need a PC, laptop, tablet or smartphone with a good internet connection, webcam, microphone and headphones if necessary, as well as the latest browser version. For optimal viewing, we recommend using a laptop or PC with a wired LAN connection.

Please note that we cannot assume any support or liability for your terminal device used (e.g. laptop or PC) or the services of external service providers, such as internet providers, Zoom or Miro.

Participants will receive a link for Zoom and, if applicable, Miro for dial-in in good time before the respective event days.

Venue/Day of Event

The venue is Pole PIXEL, 24-26-36 Rue Emile Decorps, 69100 Villeurbanne, France (<https://polepixel.fr/>). The recommended day of arrival is Thursday 8 June and departure is Wednesday 14 June.

The Development Lab starts on 9 June at 9.30 am, and is full time for five days with additional networking events in the evenings. It is recommended that you do not plan any private appointments in order to be able to participate in all activities.

The dates for the online live masterclasses are yet to be announced, they will take place in the 2 weeks before the Development Lab.

Development Lab Language

English

Eligible to participate are

all individuals who are at least 18 years old.

Application for Participation and Selection

To apply for participation in the Development Lab, please fill out the form: <https://forms.gle/9rnhUj4C6sQ22pac8>.

You will receive an automatized confirmation email about the submission of your application.

The Development Lab is limited to 35 participants. Early applications will generally be given priority. When selecting participants, the organiser will ensure that, in the spirit of the Lab's multi-disciplinarity, the broadest possible range of professional backgrounds, the greatest possible diversity in terms of cultural and national origins, and gender equity are taken into account.

The organiser will select the participants by April, 17th, 2023 at the latest. You will receive notification of the acceptance or cancellation of your participation in the

Development Lab. The contract is concluded by the written confirmation of the organiser.

Scholarships

The organiser will award a small number of scholarships to participants who are eligible according to the rules of the Creative Europe Media Programme. These are participants with the following nationalities: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Georgia, Hungary, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Luxembourg, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Slovenia, Republic of Serbia, Slovakia and Ukraine.

The decision on the awarding of scholarships remains with the event and is not legally enforceable. The scholarship holders selected by the organiser will be notified in writing.

French Residents

For French residents, this training is eligible under the Qualiopi quality standard through the entitlement to training. For more information or to find out how your costs can be covered - especially if you have a disability - please contact formation@polepixel.fr.

Participation Fees and Payment

Participants will receive an invoice for the participation fee.

Early Bird Application

(March 3rd - March 22nd, 12 pm CET)

Regular Application

(March 23rd - April 16th, 12 pm CET)

The participation fee is due for payment at the latest 10 days after the invoice date. For bank transfers from non-EU countries, please note: "All expenses to be borne by the payer", as any expenses incurred will be claimed subsequently. The participation fees will be collected via our French cooperation partner Pôle PIXEL.

If payment is not made on time, the participant will be excluded from taking part in the Development Lab.

Changes to the registration

The non-attendance at individual event units (e.g. the

online masterclasses or individual event days in Villeurbanne) will not result in a reduction or refund of the participation fees.

Cancellation

You can cancel your participation until May, 11th, 2023. In this case, you will receive a full refund of any fee paid.

In case of cancellation between May, 12th, 2023 and May, 25th, 2023, we will charge 20% of the regular participation fee (170,00 € plus VAT).

In case of cancellation between May, 26th, 2023 and June, 1st, 2023 we will charge 40% of the regular participation fee (340,00€ plus VAT).

In case of cancellation after June, 1st, 2023, no refund of the payment already made will be issued.

The cancellation must be made in writing via e-mail to info@ionda.world (subject: Cancellation). Mere non-payment of the invoice is not sufficient and will not be recognised as a cancellation.

You also have the possibility to propose a substitute person at the latest until May 11th, 2023. This must be done in writing via email (info@ionda.world). In addition, the substitute person must complete the application form in full and be accepted as a participant by the organiser. The substitute person has to pay the full regular participation fee.

Accessibility

We think inclusively. Our rooms are barrier-free and accessible for wheelchair users. Please inform us about your needs when you register.

Data Protection

Data transmitted to us is stored in the EDP system. We use this data exclusively for the fulfilment of contractual obligations (Art. 6 para. 1b DSGVO, based on your consent (Art. 6 para. 1a DSGVO) or based on legal requirements (Art. 6 para. 1c DSGVO). If you have provided us with your e-mail address, you can object to its use for advertising purposes at any time at info@ionda.world. We process personal data in accordance with the provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (DSGVO) and the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG).

Certificates of Participation

We will issue a certificate of participation in the Development Lab as evidenced by signature.

Liability

Participation in the Development Lab and the use of the organiser's premises and facilities are at the participant's own risk. The organiser is not liable for accidents, damage, loss or theft, unless caused by gross negligence.

The organiser is also not liable for the services of external service providers, such as Internet providers, Zoom, Miro or cooperation partners of the Development Lab.

Claims for damages against the organiser are excluded. Excluded from the exclusion are cases in which the organiser is at fault due to intent or gross negligence. In the event of a breach of material contractual obligations, the organiser's liability shall be limited to compensation for the direct average damage that is foreseeable and typical for the type of event, unless there is intent or gross negligence or liability for injury to life, limb or health.

Notes

The Development Lab will only take place if a functioning group is formed, and it is organisationally and technically feasible. The content and scope of the organiser's services result from the respective event offer.

As a registered participant, you guarantee that you will use any access to events or recordings provided exclusively for yourself and will not pass them on to third parties.

As a participant, you acknowledge that no claims for damages can be made against the organiser if the

Development Lab is made more complicated or prevented by unforeseen economic or political events or by force majeure in general, or if programme changes or cancellations become necessary due to the cancellation of mentors or experts. There is no entitlement to certain mentors accompanying the Development Lab, even if they have been announced. The organiser shall ensure that new mentors are also suitably qualified. Changes in this sense do not entitle the participant to withdraw from the contract or to reduce the event fee.

Corona, Force Majeure, Exceptional Situations

Should a situation arise again, in which it is not possible to hold the Development Lab as a physical event - for example due to government regulations during a pandemic - the organiser will look for possibilities to either postpone the event or hold it completely digitally / virtually. By registering, you acknowledge this reservation.

Final provisions

The contractual relationship existing between the parties and the rights and obligations arising therefrom shall be governed exclusively by the substantive law of the Federal Republic of Germany, excluding the conflict-of-law rules of private international law.

The place of performance for all obligations arising from the contractual relationship is the Organiser's registered office in Munich.

Additions or changes to the contractual relationship between participants and the organiser are only effective if they are confirmed in writing. Should any provision of these GTC be or become invalid in whole or in part, this shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions. The statutory provisions shall apply in place of the invalid provision.
